



Parent Communication

- → Text alerts for campus emergency notifications: To receive NinerAlerts, text the key word UNCCharlotteAlerts to 67283.
- → "Notes Home" used for necessary (but not urgent) information to parents regarding camper behavior
- → Pre-Camp Emails
 - ◆ 12 days out (Important Pre-Camp Info)
 - ◆ 4 days out (Reminder to Check Online Resources via the camp app)

- 5- Enjoy!





Meal Plan Overview

- → Optional \$65.00 weekly meal plan Social 704 Dining Hall (Student Union)
- → Meal plans must be purchased at least 2 weeks before the camp week
- → No refunds or transfers for meal plans
- → DO NOT send cash/card to purchase a lunch on campus
- → Contact to purchase meal plan: ceregistration@charlotte.edu

- → Covers lunch only (not snacks)

Snack & Allergy Info

- → Pack 1–2 nut-free snacks each day
- → No nut products permitted due to airborne allergies

Packed Lunch Guidelines

- → Lunch containers must be labeled with camper's name
- → No refrigeration or microwaves available
- → Include ice packs or a frozen water bottle to keep items cool



Niner Academy Lunch Time

- → ONLY Niner Academy Participants may bring cash/card to purchase from retail dining
- → Coding 7-9 class is not a niner academy program
- → Students may purchase from retail such as chick fil a or they can purchase a meal plan in advance
- → No cash/card for meal plans

Campers depart for classrooms promptly at 8:45AM

CAMPER PICK-UP: 4:15PM-5:30PM

Note: Starting at 5:35pm, there will be an additional supervision charge of \$2.50/minute

All campers will not arrive until 4:15pm; please do not arrive before that time as it will cause a traffic back-up. We recommend arriving at 4:25 or later for little to no wait time.

Last early pick-up time available is at 3:30pm.



Niner Academy

- → Guardians may choose to have their high schoolers perform self check out with their counselor to join any siblings at the Science Building. Without permission to self check out, guardians (and authorized adults) must pick up at both locations.
- → Niner Academy campers who drive themselves to campus should pay to park at the Student Union Deck or East Deck 1 and walk to the McEniry building if arriving from 7:30AM-8:40 AM. If arriving after 8:40 AM your camper will need to walk directly to their classroom.
- → At the time that students check out with program staff, they are no longer under our program supervision. Please be sure to opt for this at registration. We also encourage communicating this with your child's instructor and counselors.
- → Please call 704-687-8900 if you need to update permissions.



Late Policy

- → The latest available pick-up for is 5:30pm.
- → We encourage families to have an alternate authorized adult arranged in advance who they may call if they are ever unable to arrive by 5:30pm.
- → All authorized adults must be documented on the camper's application. Camp staff will begin to make calls at 5:30pm to parents/guardians of campers who have yet to be picked up.
- → Please note that starting at 5:35pm, there will be an additional supervision charge of \$2.50/minute which will be sent via electronic invoice.
- → Parents must pay the additional supervision charge/balance within two business days of receiving the digital invoice to retain enrollment in any future camps. Continued disregard for the pick-up time (defined as a third incident) may result in termination from the program without a refund.

What to Wear/Pack/Bring

- → Comfortable clothing
- → Recommend athletic shoes; discourage flip-flops
- → Refillable water bottle (with name)
- → Snacks (no nuts)
- → Lunch bag (with name)
- → Backpack/bag
- → Umbrella/rain gear
- → Apply sunscreen in morning
- → Basic Supplies (Pen/Pencil/Markers, etc)
- → Medications/EpiPen (will remain with child)

Parent Preparation Tips

- 1. Go over the Niner Character Promise with your camper
- 2. Watch the Drop-off and Pick-up tutorial video located in the camp app
- 3. Arrive no later than 8:30am for drop-off and no later than 5:30pm for pick-up (bring your printed dash placard)
- 4. Pack snacks (lunch)!
- 5. Last early pick-up of the day is 3:00pm (notify us by completing the Early Pick Up form in the app)
- 6. For same day or emergency early pickups, please notify us at youthprograms@charlotte.edu and call (704) 687-8900 prior to 3:00pm.
- 7. Communicate with other designated adults; share online resources with them (dash placard, location info)
- 8. Be accessible by phone (incoming #s may vary)
- 9. Communicate needs of your camper on the camp application (tips for success)
- 10. Check your camper's online resources prior to camp via the camp app



Parent Reminders

- → Label everything
- → Leave valuables at home
- → Be sure camper is registered under their name; not yours
- → Install LiveSafe App on your mobile and sign-up for emergency text alerts
- → Download the camp app prior to camp

FAQS

Q: I work on campus, can I drop my camper off in the classroom?

A: Campers may be taken to the classroom directly but at least two other people MUST be present in the classroom before you leave (Rule of 3).

Q: I forgot to add updates on my campers profile. How can I add them?

A: No worries! Please call (704) 687-8900 or email ceregistration@charlotte.edu to have that updated prior to camp.

Q: How do I complete payments online?

Q: How long do I have to enroll in a waitlisted camp?

A: Guardians have 48 hrs to enroll in a camp after receiving email notification that a waitlisted spot has opened.

Q: I forgot my dash placard for pick up- help!

A: Please be prepared to show your ID to a staff member. It is also helpful to share your child's camp and age information to expedite the process.

Q: When are payments due?

A: Payments are due 14 days prior to the start of a camp. If the remaining balance is not paid by the deadline, your child's seat in the camp will be canceled.

Q: How can I reach my child's instructor?

A: The instructor email address will be listed at the top of each agenda in your app materials. Please allow 24 hrs for a response.
